

## **CATECHU Natural Dye**

| ORIGIN                    | Catechu natural dye is made from the resinous extract of acacia trees. Our Catechu is prepared and imported from Pakistan.                            |
|---------------------------|---|
| FIBERS                    | Dyes brilliantly on all natural fibers.   |
| FASTNESS                  | Excellent fastness to light and washing.  |
| HOW MUCH<br>TO USE        | Use 10% - 25% per weight of any natural fiber (depending on desired intensity)  |
|                           | Alum gives yellow-toned brown and Copper gives a "classic" brown. Iron gives a nice dark brown.   |
| MORDANTS /FIXERS/ ASSISTS | For a very dark brown-black, add 13% - 25% by weight of <b>Logwood Extract</b> , pre-mordant with <b>Alum</b> , and dip in an <b>Iron</b> after-bath. |
| HOW TO EXTRACT            | Dissolve in hot water, raise to a near boil.  |
| HOW TO<br>DYE             | Add your wetted-out fiber to the dyepot after it reaches a near boil. Leave it in the dyebath and let it cool overnight, stirring often.              |
| DISPOSAL                  | The dyebath does keep, so you can save your vat until you're done with it, or all the dye is used up.   |
|                           | Add the spent dyestuff to your compost bin or spread around the base of plants.   |
| CARE                      | Handwash, use a mild soap such as Dr. Bronner's. <u>Do not soak</u> .   |
